MASTER AGREEMENT BETWEEN CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY, SACRAMENTO AND UNIVERSITY ENTERPRISES, INC. FOR ADMINISTRATION OF SPONSORED PROGRAMS

This Master Agreement is entered into between California State University, Sacramento, hereinafter called Sacramento State, and University Enterprises, Inc. hereinafter called UEI.

Whereas, Operating Agreement #MA140054 executed June 30, 2014 between the Chancellor of the California State University on behalf of the Board of Trustees (CSU) and UEI authorizes UEI to engage in the function and activities related to "Externally Funded Projects Including Research, Workshops, Conferences and Institutes," as specified in the California Code of Regulations.

This Agreement shall be effective July 1, 2015 through September 1, 2027 unless sooner terminated as herein provided or at such time as the aforementioned Agreement #MA140054 is terminated. This Agreement may be terminated at any time by the written agreement of both parties or upon 90 days' advance written notice by one party to the other.

This Agreement designates UEI as the Sponsored Program Administrator (SPA), as defined in CSU Executive Order 890, for all Sponsored Projects except for those awards which benefit the Associated Students, Inc. programs and for those awards which the University's Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs or designee, Vice President for Administration/CFO or designee, and the Executive Director of UEI or designee mutually agree the University shall administer.

UEI agrees to indemnify, defend, and save harmless the State, the Trustees of the California State University, Chancellor, and University, their officers, agents and employees of each of them (all of which are hereinafter referred to collectively as "State") from any and all loss, damage, or liability that may be suffered or incurred by State, caused by, arising out of, or in any way connected with the administration of Sponsored Programs by UEI. UEI shall also carry adequate insurance in accordance with CSU policy.

UEI agrees to provide grant and contract services to ensure the administration of externally funded projects complies with the campus policy for Sponsored Projects Administration, federal and state regulations, funding agency regulations, and University and UEI policies and procedures.

This Agreement may be amended at any time by mutual agreement of the parties without additional consideration, provided that before any amendment shall take effect, it shall be reduced to writing and signed by both parties.

This Agreement sets forth the entire agreement between the parties and fully supersedes any and all prior agreements or understandings, written or oral, between the parties pertaining to the subject matter hereof.
